### DISTANCE LEARNING COMPONENTS



#### CONTENT DELIVERY

- Students will have access to digital materials and instructional activities to remain engaged in learning during the time schools may remain closed.
- Our district sets up a gmail account for all students upon registering. Usernames and passwords are available through each child's school.
- Digital resources will be in the form of either Core Materials or Supplemental Materials. Core Materials will be used as the main instructional programs for all students in each designated grade level and Supplemental Materials will be available for enhancement/enrichment activities, conducting research or recreational/enhanced learning.
- Weekly "Distance Learning" plans for your child, through your child's school/teacher, can be accessed from home. The purpose of these plans shifts from reinforcing previously learned skills to a greater focus on new skills and new learning experiences.
- Schools will also provide families information about how to access digital platforms like Google Classroom and Google Meet, if help is needed.

#### MOBILE DEVICES

- District students/families in grades K-8 are surveyed to determine if they have a need for a mobile device at home to access instructional activities.
- The school district will check out mobile devices to those students or parents who have indicated they need a mobile device for use at home.
- The school district will use current inventory of mobile devices, including devices in carts, to check out to students, where needed.
- Mobile devices must be checked out from the school or district office on a borrowing agreement.



#### INTERNET ACCESS

- To date, the district has purchased wifi hotspots for those families, who are most in need of access to the internet, to support students' distance learning activities and lessons.
- The district is also investigating additional partnerships with service providers to provide internet access to students/families if schools continue closure status.
